CONTENT & ACTIVITIES	28 Course offers access to a variety of engaging methods to present content, support learning and collaboration, and facilitate regular and substantive interaction with the instructor.	Required
	29 Course provides activities for learners to develop higher-order thinking and problem-solving skills, such as critical reflection and analysis.	Required
	30 Course materials and resources are appropriately cited.	Required
	31 Text content is available in an easily accessed format. All text content is readable by assistive technology, including a PDF or any text contained in an image.	Required
	32 A text equivalent for every non-text element is provided ("alt" tags, captions, transcripts, etc.), and audio description is provided for video-only content.	Required
	33 Hyperlink text describes the linked resource and how to interact with it, such as "read," "view," etc. The hyperlink makes sense when out of context (Using "Click Here" is avoided).	Required
	34 Course provides activities that emulate real world applications of the discipline, such as experiential learning, case studies, and problem-based activities.	Highly Suggested
	35 Text, graphics, and images are understandable when viewed without color or other stylistic elements. 36 Where available, Open Educational Resources, free, or low cost materials are used.	Highly Sugg. Suggested
INTERACTION	37 Regular and substantive instructor-to-student interactions are present and appropriate for the course.	Required
	38 Expectations for all course interactions (instructor to student, student to student, student to instructor) are clearly explained.	Required
	39 Course offers opportunities for learner to learner interaction and constructive collaboration.	Required
	40 Students are encouraged to share resources and inject knowledge from diverse sources of information in their course interactions.	Highly Suggested
ASSESSMENT & FEEDBACK	41 Course grading policies, including instructor feedback and late student submission policies, are clearly stated in the Course Information and/or Syllabus materials.	Required
	42 Course includes frequent and appropriate methods to assess the learners' mastery of content (formative).	Required
	43 Criteria for the assessment of a graded assignment (summative) are clearly articulated.	Required
	44 Learners are informed when a timed response is required. Proper lead time is provided to ensure there is an opportunity to prepare an accommodation.	Required
	45 Learners have easy access to a well-designed and up-to-date gradebook.	Required
	46 Course provides opportunities for learners to review their performance and assess their own learning throughout the course (via pre-tests, self-tests with feedback, reflective assignments, peer assessment, etc.).	Highly Suggested
